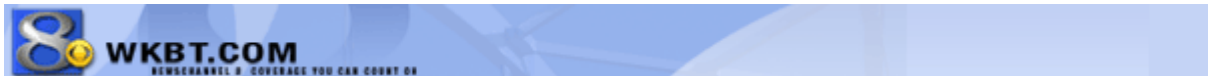

## Report: La Crosse 14th Healthiest County in Wisconsin

A new study says La Crosse County is the 14th healthiest in Wisconsin

The study released by the University of Wisconsin-Madison [Population Health Institute](#) ranks Crawford County 35, and Vernon County was ranked 39. Jackson (66), Monroe (65), Trempealeau (50) Buffalo (42) and Juneau (69) counties ranked in the bottom half.

Southeastern Wisconsin is home to some of the state's healthiest, and least healthy, people.

The study Milwaukee is one of the unhealthiest places to live in the state, but suburban Ozaukee and Waukesha counties are among the healthiest.

Pat Remington is director of the UW Population Health Institute and says the study calls attention to the fact there are health discrepancies in Wisconsin.

A healthy county is considered one where people live to be 75 and older, their health is generally good and their quality of life is high.

Along with Ozaukee and Waukesha counties, Dane County, home to Madison and state government, ranked as the healthiest.

Menominee County, home of the Menominee Tribe in northeast Wisconsin, was once again the least healthiest, followed by the city of Milwaukee and Marquette County in central Wisconsin.
